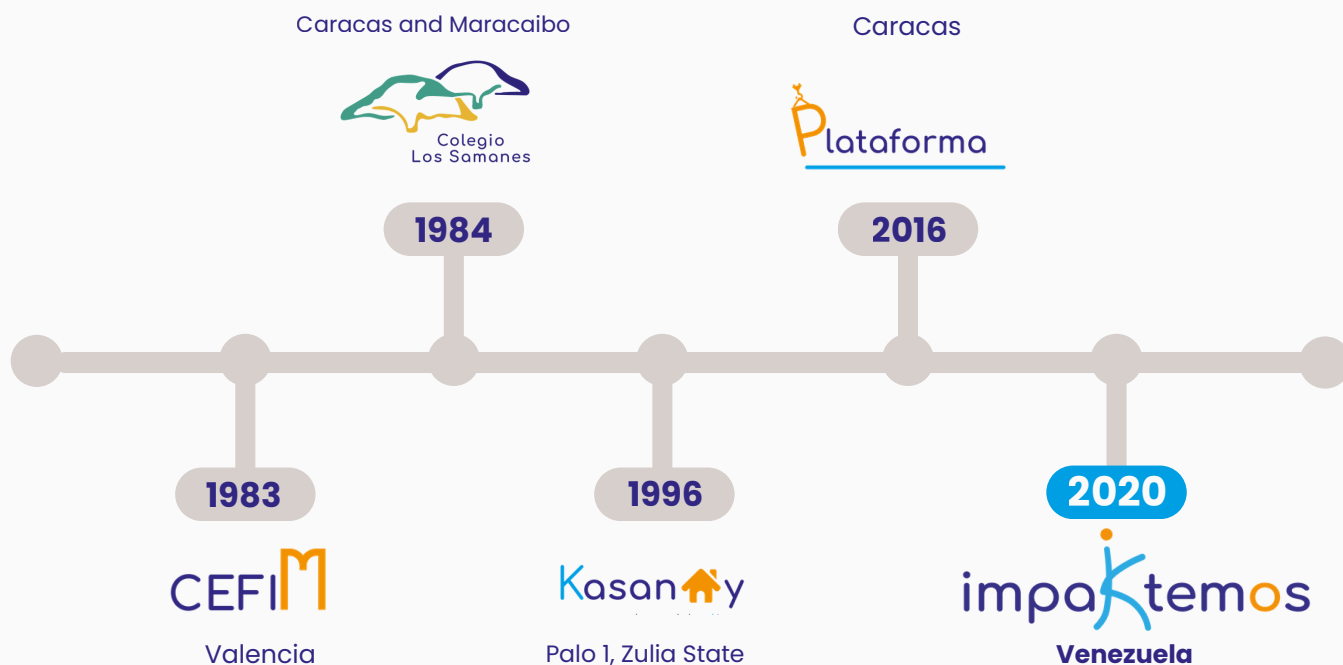

During 2025 we participated in various funding calls, with the goal of strengthening our educational programs through attractive and challenging projects.

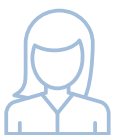
Each proposal represents another step in our commitment to transforming lives through education and sustainable development.
